DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Assists the Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO) in ensuring the intelligence function maintains a capability to provide timely and accurate operational intelligence support and fully trained intelligence personnel during peacetime and contingency operations. Assists in training and testing aircrew on worldwide threats that could potentially affect mission success to include adversary surface-to-air missile (SAM) systems, air-to-air missiles (AAMs), anti-aircraft artillery (AAA), and aircraft. Develops scenarios for unit training missions. Provides clarity to mission training and employment taking into account worldwide threat employment capabilities, tactics, techniques, and procedures. Creates and updates Threat of the Day (TOD) files for mission planning study for peacetime and contingency operations. Performs assigned operational intelligence research and analysis, and, based on thorough understanding of the significance of conditions and trends, develops and projects data and draws meaningful assessments and clear estimates based on historical and current intelligence. Provides detailed threat analysis for mission planning and pre-mission briefings. Subject matter expert on debriefing aircrews flying all mission types, extracting critical information on mission results and threats encountered. Provides in-depth finished analysis of missions through the fusing of Mission Reports (MISREPs). Assists the SIO in aircrew pre-deployment spin-up training. Creates and briefs pre-deployment intelligence information to support personnel assigned to AEF and OCONUS deployments. Performs other duties as assigned.

PLACEMENT FACTORS: Applicants should demonstrate through prior experience, education and training the following: (1) Working knowledge of intelligence support operations, procedures, and practices. (2) Ability to conduct preliminary examination and interpretation of intelligence data for economic, geographic, political, military topics and threats. (3) Ability to brief findings and estimates to superiors, planners and policy makers and provide detailed intelligence analysis from mission planning, aircrew briefings and debriefings. (4) Ability to perform as the primary intelligence specialist for the Mission Planning Cell (MPC). (5) Ability to prepare and conduct training on intelligence systems, order of battle maintenance, mission planning, threat analysis, and GI&S support. (6) Ability to plan and develop objectives and work schedules for training of intelligence personnel during Regularly Scheduled Drill, Annual Training, and unit deployments. (7) Ability to perform complex intelligence analysis of all pertinent threat weapon systems and geopolitical conditions that could impact the unit's mission success through comprehensive working knowledge of intelligence support operations, procedures, and practice. (8) Skill in working with personal computers and specialized software.

Graduate of the Intelligence Weapons Instructor Course is preferred. Upon selection, must become a member of the 148th FW MNANG, and will be assigned to a compatible military position in AFSC 14NX. Follow on technical training will be required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must be 18 years or older and commissioned prior to his/her 35th birthday. All applicants must submit proof of citizenship and be citizens of the United States IAW Title 32, U.S.C., Section 313. A baccalaureate or higher degree from an educational institution listed in the current Accredited Institutions of Post Secondary Education is required for all appointment.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to obtain and maintain a Top Secret security clearance with eligibility for SCI access.

QUALIFICATION AND SELECTION FACTORS: Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, sex or National origin. Applications are subject to review by the MPF and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB). The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are minimum for Nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in AFI 36-2005 and ANGI 36-2005.
